**Information for People Applying for Unemployment Insurance**

This is your **monetary redetermination**. This form shows the dollar amount of unemployment benefits you will be allowed, if you meet all other requirements.

If this form shows you did not have high enough wages to qualify for unemployment benefits, your wages for another time period will be reviewed and the results will be sent to you shortly.

Your weekly benefit amount is based on your wages during a portion of the last 15 to 18 months. The maximum benefits available to you is either 26 times your weekly benefit amount **OR** 1/3 of the wages you were paid in your base period, whichever amount is less. Please refer to Maine's Unemployment Insurance Guide at <https://www.maine.gov/unemployment/uiguide/> for a detailed explanation of your "base period."

If you have worked in another state, you may be eligible for benefits by combining your employment and wages in another state where you have worked. If you earned wages working in another state, please contact the claims center at 1-800-593-7660.

If the information on this form is not correct, call the office listed on the other side of this form. We have the authority to correct decisions if there is an error in the weekly benefit amount, the maximum benefits available, or the amount of wages reported. The correction must be made within one year of the mail date on the original decision.

If, after you call the call center, you still think the information or benefits decision is incorrect, you may file an appeal with the Division of Administrative Hearings. **An appeal must be filed within 15 days of the date this form was mailed.** The date mailed is listed at the top of this form. An additional 15 days may be allowed for **good cause**. The Division of Administrative Hearings cannot accept an appeal received after the 15-day period, except when it has been determined there is "good cause" to do so.
